
As you may know, we are considering several initiatives in the road transport sector in the near future. These initiatives include a possible revision of Regulation (EC) No 1071/2009 on access to the occupation of road transport operator and of Regulation (EC) No 1072/2009 on access to the international road transport market. We have already carried out an evaluation of the existing legislation which detected several shortcomings¹. In the context of this initiative, we will shortly be launching an open public consultation.
